He or she may also provide treatment such as cognitive rehabilitation, behavior management, or psychotherapy. Often the neuropsychologist will work closely with physician to manage the child’s problems. Some pediatric neuropsychologists work closely with schools to help them provide appropriate educational programs for the child.</p>
