Formal testing of abilities such as memory and language skills assess brain functioning. The pediatric neuropsychologist conducts the evaluation, interprets the test results, and makes recommendations. The neuropsychologist may work in many different settings and may have different roles neuropsychologist is a cast manager who follows the child over time to adjust recommendations to the child's changing needs. He or she may also provide treatment such as cognitive rehabilitation, behavior management, or psychotherapy. Often the neuropsychologist will work closely with physician to manage the child's problems. Some pediatric neuropsychologists work closely with schools to help them provide appropriate educational programs for the child.
