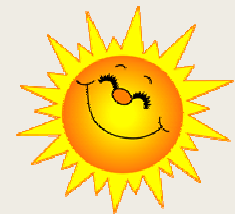

**Did You Know:** The name and concept of Earth Day was pioneered by [John McConnell](#) in 1969 at a [UNESCO](#) Conference in San Francisco. He proposed March 21, 1970, the first day of spring in the northern hemisphere. This day of nature's equinox was later sanctioned in a Proclamation signed by Secretary General [U Thant](#) at the [United Nations](#). A month later a separate Earth Day was founded by [United States Senator Gaylord Nelson](#) as an environmental [teach-in](#) first held on April 22, 1970. While this April 22, Earth Day was focused on the United States, an organization launched by [Denis Hayes](#), who was the original national coordinator in 1970, took it international in 1990 and organized events in 141 nations. Numerous communities celebrate **Earth Week**, an entire week of activities focused on environmental issues.
