Welcome Baby & Beyond builds confidence in parenting skills and helps caregivers understand their child's developmental needs from birth to age 5.

Welcome Baby & Beyond aims to promote a safe, healthy, and positive environment to support families and children.

Welcome Baby & Beyond supports parents and caregivers with:

- Prenatal support and education for a healthy pregnancy
- Addressing parenting questions and challenges through education, support, and connection to other resources
- Mental health support and screenings for the parents and caregivers, and referrals to services, if desired
- Understanding their child's developmental, social, and emotional needs
- Early childhood screenings to assess motor, language, speech, and development
- Information, guidance, and support for parents using the "Parents as Teachers" model, which helps them learn and understand the developmental needs of their children and adopt parenting practices that support those needs
- Preparing children for school readiness
